Vaccine introduced in 2006. Only 1 in 7 eligible girls currently vaccinated.

4 in 10



Just 4 in 10 women get screened for cervical cancer in low and middle-income countries.

What We Know

- Every **90** seconds, we lose a woman to cervical cancer
- **90%** of these women live in LMICs
- **85%** of women impacted are young
- Vaccines can prevent almost all cervical cancer deaths if given early enough
- Timely screening and affordable and accessible treatment can catch and potentially eliminate the disease.
